

CROSSING GUARD, Paw Paw Village Police Department, Michigan

The Village of Paw Paw Police Department is seeking candidates to fill a part-time crossing guard position. The position requires one hour of work in the morning between 7:50am and 8:50am and one hour in the afternoon between 3:30pm and 4:30pm. Half day hours are normally 12:00 noon to 1:00pm. The Paw Paw Public School year starts September 5, 2017 and ends June 14, 2018. The position assists children going to the Elementary Schools off of North St.

Job Description:

School crossing guards monitor street crossing when children come and go to school at appointed times each day. They assist children in safely crossing the road and help to identify unsafe drivers in the school zone area. They report any unsafe behavior to our public school system and when needed can ask for assistance from the police department. Crossing guards are courteous and kind. They receive training from the Village Police Department prior to the start of the school year.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 18 years of age
- High School Graduate or GED
- Should be able to work outdoors in all weather conditions
- Should have good judgment as they interact with children and parents
- No felony convictions
- Must pass a background check and drug screening
- Must successfully complete all phases of the selection process

Starting wage is \$11:00 per hour, equipment provided.
